

15440.01: Admission Requirements

POLICY: Students for Hendrick Medical Center School of Radiography are selected twice a year for Abilene and once a year for the outreach program with clinical sites in San Angelo, Brownwood, Eastland, and Comanche. All candidates are selected based on a point system. Application steps and points are listed below.

RULES:

1. Complete Pre-application Radiologic Seminar by Prior to the Application Deadline.
2. Complete aptitude test after the Pre-application Radiologic Seminar. Cost \$25
3. Complete application and return by January 1 deadline for April class or June 1 deadline for September class.
4. Submit official college transcripts documenting Associate degree or higher with transferable college credit in:
Written/oral communication (English 6 hrs) Mathematical/logical reasoning (Math 3 hrs)
Anatomy & Physiology * (3 hrs) Medical Terminology * (1 hr)

Applicants must have a "C" or better in required classes. Remedial/Developmental classes are not accepted.

Transcripts must be submitted no later than the January 31 deadline for the April class or the June 30 deadline for the September class.

* Non-credit courses in Anatomy & Physiology and Medical Terminology may be taken through the program at an additional cost.

Anatomy & Physiology- \$210 Medical Terminology - \$140.

5. Application Points
Neat and complete 5 points

GPA based on pre-req. classes 0-20 points
(Applicants must have a 2.0 or better in required prerequisite classes)

Reference letters 50 point maximum
(points based on best 3 of 5 reference forms)

BA,BS, Master degree 10 points
reapplying alternate 5 points
6. The test and application scores are averaged and the applicants with the highest scores are interviewed by the program selection committee.

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7. Scores from the application, test, and interview are averaged and the applicants with the top scores are selected for admission to the program.
8. Acceptance into the program is contingent upon successful completion of a criminal history and drug screening.
9. Full – time students complete 22 hours per week. The program does not enroll part – time students. The program does not accept transfer or advanced placement students.
